- Limits may change due to horse

Pre-Registration Required: Deposit check of \$125 due with registration (\$65 for 2 or 3 day camps), balance due (cash/check) the first day of camp session, though it may be paid earlier. Confirmation Packet will be mailed upon receipt of deposit.
